CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Acceptance	Entries will be dated as received, in the event of entries exceeding the limit a reserve list will be drawn up. Please note that members will get first preference. Numbers in some classes may be restricted at the discretion of the committee. Late or phone/fax entries will only be accepted at the committees discretion and those accepted may incur a penalty of \$10 per test.
Riders	Riders can ride two horses per test only. <u>Horses may not compete in more than 2 consecutive levels eg: Preliminary/Novice.</u> Three tests per horse in a single day and six tests per rider per day. Riders of multiple horses should indicate in which order they wish to ride their horses - this will allow sufficient warm up time etc.
Juniors	Juniors will have separate sections from Preliminary through to Novice. Junior Champion Annual point scores are accumulated on the best two scores 55% and over in Junior nominated Preliminary to Novice level tests only, by the same horse & rider combination. There will be no Junior Champion for the day awarded during 2009
Pony	Ponies may enter any test but must indicate that they are a Pony. There will be no Pony Champion of the Day during 2009. Annual Pony Champion will be assessed by best two scores for each pony and actually placing in a test. Points to be awarded as 3 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3rd then 1 extra point awarded for each rider beaten to 6th place.
Tests	All tests are subject to the availability of judges. The SDC reserves the right to alter the program if the need arises.
Preparatory	Preparatory is open to horses who have not won a preparatory test or higher previously.
Whips	Whips must not exceed 1.2m in its entirety (incl. tassel) and may be used up to and including FEI classes.
Hats	AS/NZS 3838, EN1384 OR ASTN F1163 HARD HATS MUST BE WORN WHILST RIDING.
Callers	Callers are allowed for all tests except FEI
Please Note	<u>There is no lunging of horses inside the main arena.</u>
Scratchings & Refunds	Scratchings should be made as soon as possible to 0409 743718. If before closing date a refund will be given. After closing date you will receive a refund only if a Vet Certificate is produced and then at the discretion of the Committee.
Awards & Mail Out of Tests	Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place and will be attached to test papers available for collection at the completion of the competition. If you cannot wait please leave appropriate coinage (e.g. 1c, \$2, or \$3.00) depending on the number of tests, & a self addressed envelope with the Secretarys Office. Champions at each level (Prelim to FEI only) will be awarded at the end of the day.
Weather	It is the responsibility of the competitors to contact 0409 743718 in view of inclement weather. We will not be ringing competitors if the competition is cancelled. All efforts will be made to make a decision as early as possible.

CONDITIONS OF HIRE

HORSE OR CATTLE EVENT

- ❖ **Bond of \$1000 must be paid prior to the Horse or Cattle Event** – this will be returned 7 days after event if facilities have been left in proper order.
- ❖ **No Glass is to be brought onto the Showground.**
- ❖ **The Showground facilities are to be treated with care.**
- ❖ **Vehicles are to park in authorised areas only.**
- ❖ **Horses or Cattle are only to be in areas as per agreement between the organisers of the event and the NAA Inc.**
- ❖ **No Animals are to be tied to any tree or tethered in such close proximity to trees that they can damage them. Any animal owner contravening this rule will be asked to leave the Showground.**
- ❖ **No rope or electric fences allowed during event. No temporary yards made out of any material. No extension of existing yards will be permitted.**
- ❖ **Owners of Horses or Cattle are responsible for cleaning the area where their animals have been stabled or tethered.**
- ❖ **All rubbish must be removed and placed in bins provided.**
- ❖ **In the event of large amounts of rubbish an additional fee will apply (by negotiation)**
- ❖ **Toilets (if used) are to be left clean, swept and moped (brooms, mops and detergent provided)**
- ❖ **Important notice to all participants:** Any participants intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. All electrical leads must be off the ground. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1983. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any participants who do not comply will not be allowed on the showground.
- ❖ **Any keys given to the hirer for access are to be returned to the caretaker at completion of the function or with 24 hours.**
